2024 NCCCAF Team Badminton Open (Open to Public)
8/24/2024

Date & Time: Saturday, 8/24/2024, Starts at 9:00am

Location: California Badminton Academy, 46049 Warm Springs Boulevard, Fremont, CA 94539

Events: 4 Team Division Competition, open to public community

Flights: 4 Team Division as follows:

- Open division: Open (no age or skill restriction for men or women)
- 30+ age division: Men's born <=1994, women 25+ or born <=1999
- 40+ age division: Men's born <=1984, women 35+ or born <=1989
- 50+ age division: Men's born <=1974, women 45+ or born <=1979

*Due to court and time limitations, limit a maximum of # of teams <=28

*No current or ex-professionally trained state/national players, No commissioned/paid/salaried professional or assistant coaches (full-time or part-time).

Registration: Go to www.NCCCAF.org, Click Badminton, Click registration

1. Complete the online form with all the information & print the registration form.
2. Please write the check payable to: "CBA" and submit the check + registration form to the CBA front desk
3. Teams are qualified to play once we receive both the registration form and payment by 8/10/2024
4. Register as soon as possible. We reserve the right to limit # divisions and # teams & stop accepting registration due to limited time and court availability to complete the competition within 1 day.

Fees: \$270.00 for all group teams (paid registration by 8/10/2024)
\$310.00 for team late registration (after 8/10, before 8/17)

Registration Deadline: Aug.10, 2024. Note that all team captains or rep. must & should attend the team drawing meeting on 8/17/2024. No new registration will be accepted after the draw.

Awards: First place team: Medals for each team player + Cash prize to be announced.
Second place and third place teams: Medals for each team player.

Draws: All Captains (or send rep.) must attend the team Draw meeting (8/17/2024 at 10 am) at the CBA office area. Draw results will be emailed to all team captains by 8/19/2024.

Waiver: The waiver form must be signed and returned to NCCCAF tournament officials before the tournament starts. Each team has to complete 1 team waiver form signed by all participants.

The captain is responsible for obtaining 1 team waiver form and returns to the appropriate volunteer desk (open, 30+, 40+, or 50+).

Game Rules:

1. World Badminton Association rules apply. Uses a 21 points system for all the matches.
2. Teams that are late by 10 min. will be disqualified. 5 minutes of warm-up is allowed before each match. Each player should bring their birdies and rackets for each competition.
3. Each player can only compete in one team. Every player can play a maximum of two matches per team competition. However, the **same partnering team can only compete in 1 match (needs to change partner for 2nd match)**.
4. For team competition, the winning team must win three of five matches.
5. All teams must compete for 5 matches (volunteer desk to coordinate order & court assignment):
 - a. Open division: 1 Single, 2 Doubles (male or female), 1 Women's Double & 1 byMixed Double. Order is S, WD, D1, MD & D2 per planned.
 - b. For all Age team divisions: 3 Doubles (male or female), 1 Women's Double & 1 Mixed Double. Order is: D1, WD, D2, MD & D3 per planned.
6. Each team should have at least 5 but no more than 12 team players. All matches will be scheduled by NCCCAF. The captain must submit the player's name on the game roster 15 minutes before the match starts. No roster change is allowed afterward.
7. NCCCAF and its officials reserve the right to check players' identification for each Team Competition. We reserve the right to check ID (driver's license) if ANYONE questions players age for non-open teams.
8. Per the captain meeting agreement, if any team cheats with a player's age or uses an incorrect player according to the player roster, that team match will be forfeited (not just the game, the cheating team will get zero points for that team match). No appeal allowed.
9. The captain can submit up to 2 players change/team due to injury before game day. During the game, if any player gets injured, that game will be forfeited (no player exchange).
10. For the team competition, tie breakers are set by (1) team record, (2) set score, (3) point score, (4) head-head record.

General logistics:

1. The captain is responsible for representing their team so the captain should never leave CBA GYM to avoid forfeit or disqualification. Captain should get to CBA by 8:40 am -> check in with their team at the volunteer desk and submit their team waiver form.
2. Competitors should plan to be at CBA at least 15 min. before game time
3. All competitors are encouraged to carpool or vanpool the day of the competition due to limited parking for all teams (250-300+ competitors) during the day of the competition.
4. Do not park across the street (Supermarket parking lot) or hotel parking next door as your vehicle may be towed (at your expense).
5. Drinks and dry food (snacks) are allowed only at the designated bag area. Please clean up in case of spills to avoid potential injury to players or visitors.
6. Teams may plan to order food and deliver to CBA but only consumed outside (on a rotation basis) to avoid missing games (check with the volunteer desk for gap time for team members to eat or rest). There is NO designated lunchtime for any teams.
7. We have reserved Court#19 & Court#20 specifically for all teams to place their bags and belongings. Please do not bring bags or belongings into the play court area.
